- That contradiction deserves to be part of this moment. You cannot celebrate freedom while ruling a colony.



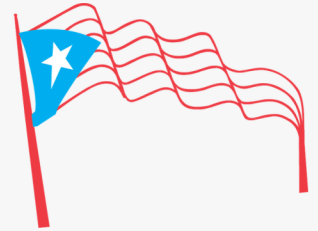
Why Chicago:

Chicago is home to more than 110,000 Puerto Ricans. Humboldt Park, known as Barrio Borikén, has been a center of Puerto Rican culture, organizing, and civic life for generations. 2026 marks the 60th anniversary of the Division St. Rebellion, when our people stood up and changed this city forever.

A "JOLGORIO" is a vibrant and boisterous Puerto Rican celebration that goes far beyond a simple party, embodying a deep sense of joyful community spirit. These lively gatherings are fueled by energetic traditional music—like bomba, plena, or festive aguinaldos—and classic foods such as perrito and coquito. This jolgorio will be an inclusive, multi-generational event where family, friends, and neighbors come together for a spirited night of dancing, eating, and celebrating life "a lo Boricua."
